 - 3) Edified the church (1 Corinthians 14:3-4; Ephesians 4:12)
 - 4) United and protected the church (Ephesians 4:14)
 - 5) Warned of future difficulties (Acts 11:27; 20:23; 21:4, 10-14)
 - 6) Confirmed faith in times of controversy (Acts 15:32)

The 4 Spiritual Tests of a Prophet

1) They must confess Jesus as the Christ

 $\underline{1 \ John \ 4:1-3}$ - This is more than just a vocal assent that Jesus is the Christ, for even the demons can do that! (Lk. 8:28)

This is an acknowledgment of the Biblical teaching of Jesus' incarnation, virgin birth, His deity, His pre-existence, His true humanity, His atoning sacrifice, resurrection, ascension, High Priestly ministry, and second coming!

2) They must agree with God's law and the Bible

<u>Isaiah 8:20</u> - God uses His prophets as His spokesmen/spokeswomen. He cannot contradict what He has said, because He cannot lie. Therefore if a prophet speaks in contradiction to the Bible, they are not a genuine prophet of God.

3) Their messages must come to pass

Jeremiah 28:9, Deuteronomy 18:20-22 - God's warnings are to correct His children and direct them back to Him through confession and repentance. If the prophet's prophecies are not of a conditional nature, and do not come to pass, they are a false prophet.

4) Their lives must match up with God's word

<u>Matthew 7:15-20</u> - While prophets are human (Js 5:17) and can make mistakes, the general trend of their life should be unto holiness. By God's grace they will be living and practicing what they preach.

The 6 Physical Tests of a Prophet

- * Important Note: The physical tests of a prophet while in vision occurred at times for the edification and establishment of the faith of those present. Although one or multiple of these physical phenomena accompanied those in prophetic vision, they did not always.
- * Another thing to keep in mind is that these physical phenomena can be imitated by Satan since he can work miracles (Rev. 16:14).
 But a false prophet cannot pass all 4 spiritual tests of a prophet.

1) Loses all natural strength

Daniel 10:8, 16, 17

- 2) Is supernaturally strengthened Daniel 10:18-19
 - 3) Have their eyes open <u>Numbers 24:3</u>
 - **4) Does not breathe** Daniel 10:17
 - 5) Tongue controlled by the Lord <u>2 Samuel 23:2</u>
 - 6) Unconscious of natural surroundings
