## The Interpretation of Daniel 7

### The Unsatisfactory Interpretation

**Daniel 7:17, 18** 'Those great beasts, which are four, are four kings which arise out of the earth. But the saints of the Most High shall receive the kingdom, and possess the kingdom forever, even forever and ever.'

### The Little Horn

#### **Daniel 7:25**

- The saints shall be given into his hand for a time, times, and half a time."

1 Day	1 Year
1 Week	7 Years
1 Month	30 Years
1 Year	360 Years

### Judgment in Heaven

**Daniel 7:26, 27** "But the court shall be seated, And they shall take away his dominion, To consume and destroy it forever. Then the kingdom and dominion, And the greatness of the kingdoms under the whole heaven, Shall be given to the people, the saints of the Most High. His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, And all dominions shall serve and obey Him."

### **Reviewing the Evidence**

The Antichrist power would...

- be the culmination of an influence "already at work" in Christianity during the time of imperial Rome
- rise after the division of Rome into ten regional kingdoms, "uprooting" three in the process
- be "revealed" (come to power) at a specific time and remain dominant exactly 1260 years
- be a small kingdom within the geographic territory of Europe
- have no military force of its own, but would instead rely on the strength of other kingdoms
- "think to change times and law" and "persecute the saints of the Most High."
- have a vocal and self-aggrandizing leader ("eyes of a man and a mouth speaking pompous words")
- be in existence until the return of Jesus (destroyed "with the brightness of His coming")

There is only one power on earth that fits every one of those criteria... the Roman Catholic Papacy.
