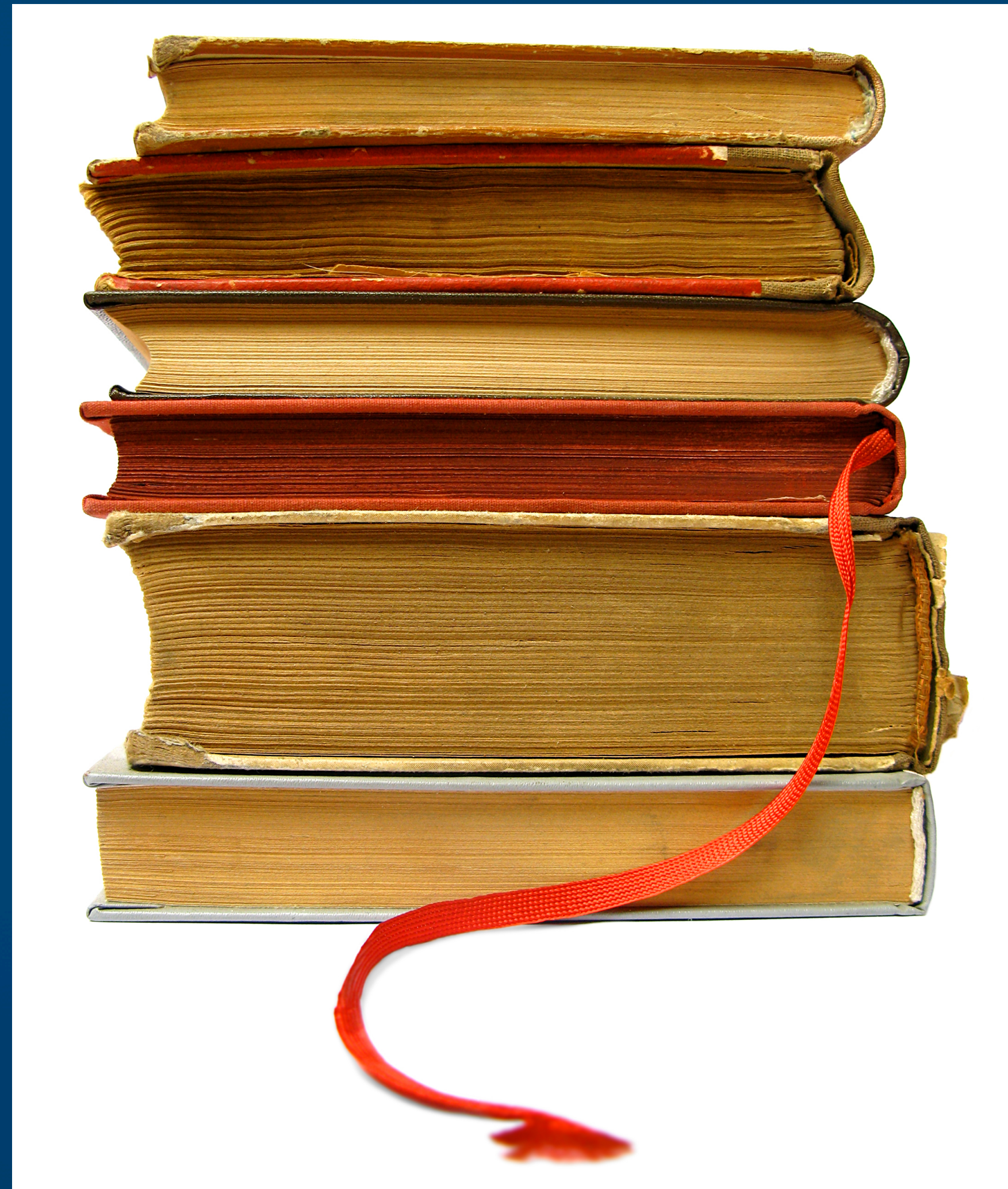

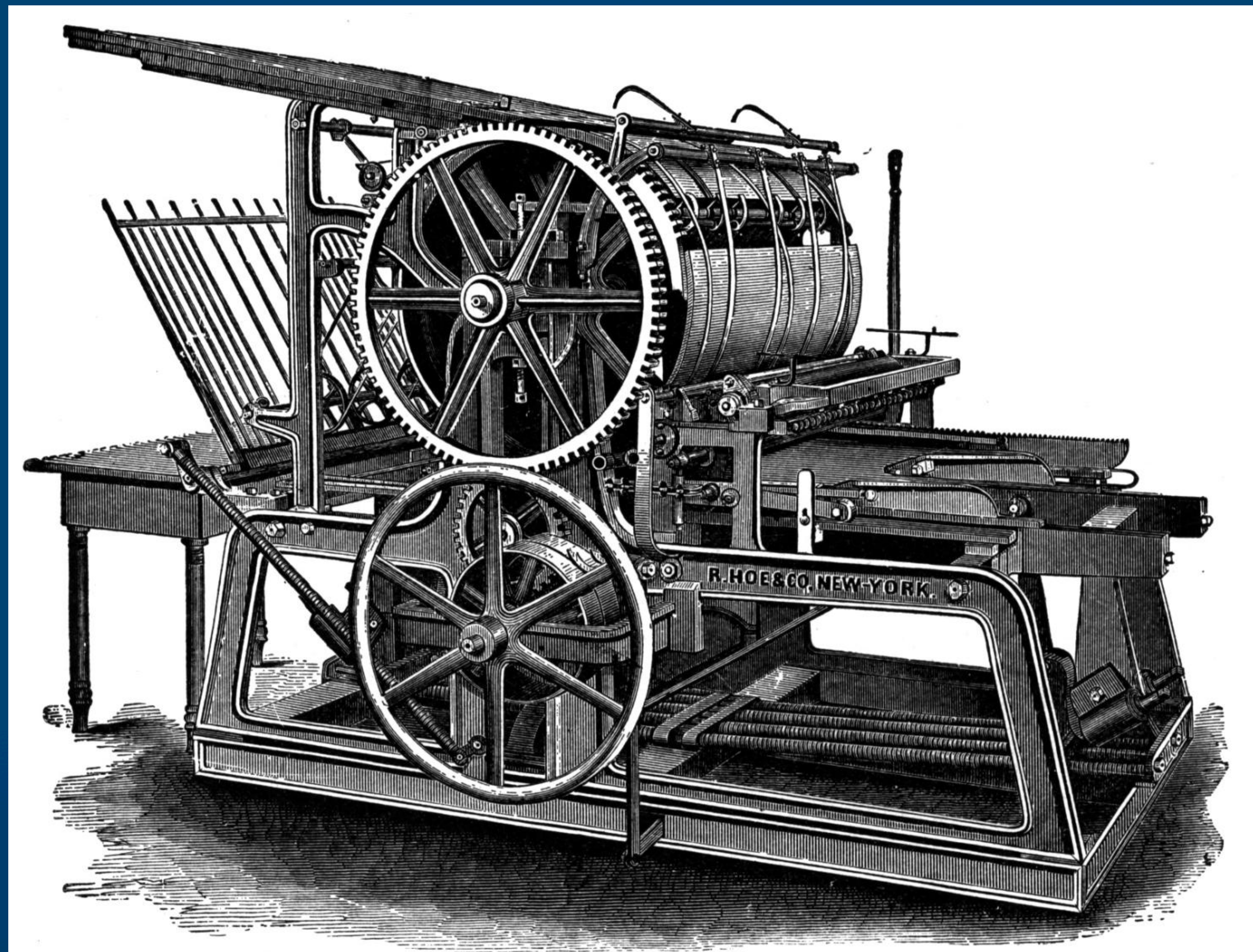

Finishing the Work

“By thousands of voices, all over the earth, the warning will be given. Miracles will be wrought, the sick will be healed, and signs and wonders will follow the believers. The message will be carried not so much by argument as by the deep conviction of the Spirit of God. The arguments have been presented...

Finishing the Work

...The seed has been sown, and now it will spring up and bear fruit. The publications distributed by missionary workers have exerted their influence, yet many whose minds were impressed have been prevented from fully comprehending the truth or from yielding obedience...

Finishing the Work

...Now the rays of light penetrate everywhere, the truth is seen in its clearness. . . . **A large number take their stand upon the Lord's side.**”

Importance in the End

- “In the writings of Ellen White we have “the information needed for the rest of the journey.”
- Her writings, which she described as “the most important books that have ever come before the churches and the world”, will “constantly speak” “as long as time shall last.”

Importance in the End

[...]Or with other words, all the way up till the Second Coming God intends to speak through these messages.

- Not only that, the work of the writings “will go forward as long as time shall last”. And after her death, she prophesied, the messages would “be of even more vital force” than when she was living!

Importance in the End

“[...]So, to conclude, is it correct to say that Ellen White was a prophet with an important function in the beginning of our movement but we don't really need her today? God's answer, through His servant, is a resounding: no! Rather, she is of special importance today. We are told that her function today and until the Second Coming is more important – extremely important.

Importance in the End

It's vital, absolutely necessary, it's essential. God wants her to have an even stronger, an even more powerful influence in the church and in the world today. God wants her to equip and change the motion of the body of Christ as never before. In light of the mighty impact she had in the world and in our church during her 70 years of active ministry, this is truly an astounding and hopeful statement!

Importance in the End

Fellow Christian, Ellen White wasn't just a prophet for *that* generation, she is truly a prophet for *this* generation. God rose her up to instruct, equip, encourage and protect us – all the way from 1844 until we safely reach the Heavenly harbor. And it is of utmost importance that we earnestly hear and heed the testimony of Jesus through His prophet for these last days!

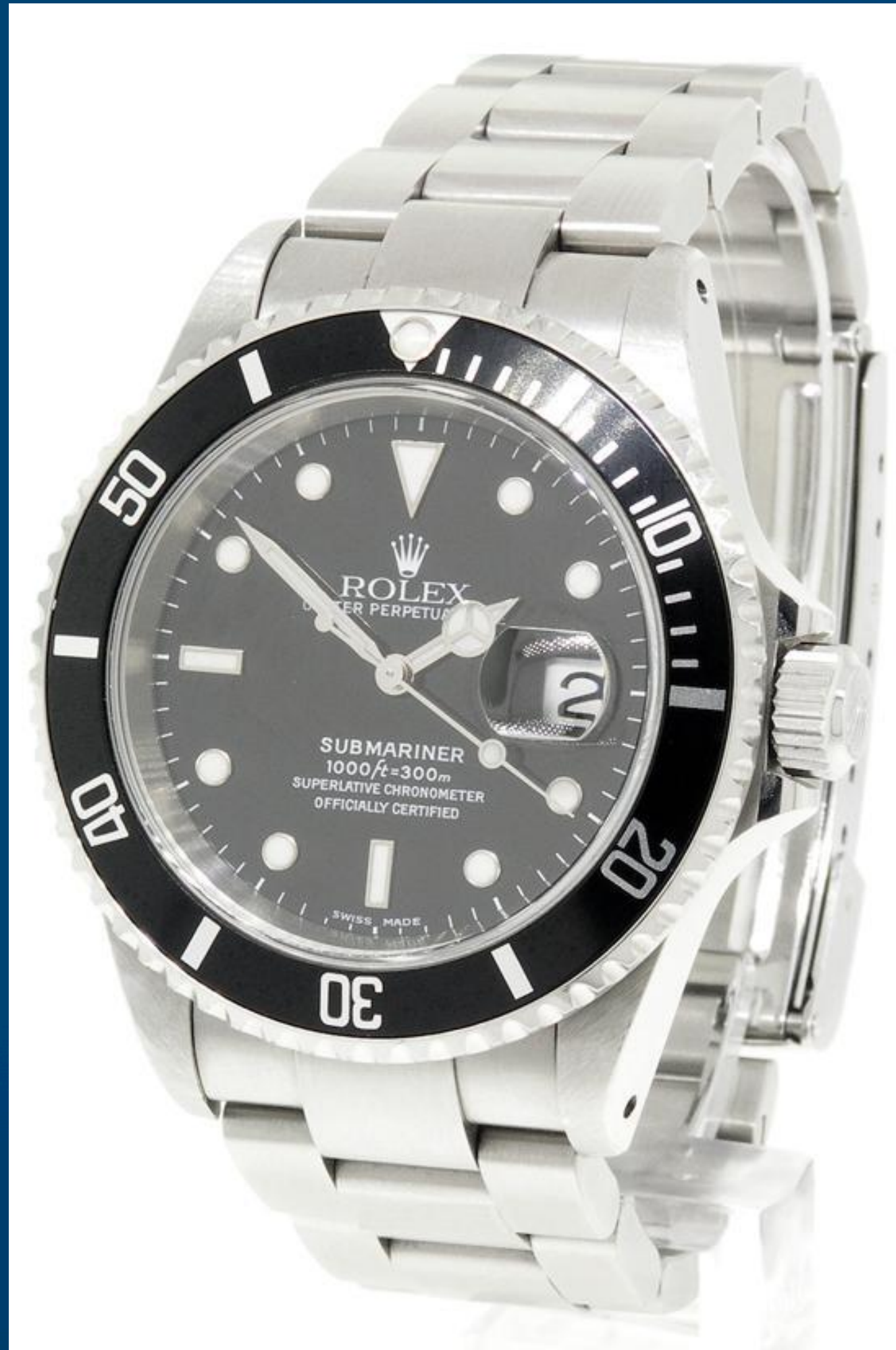

We know not what may be the results of giving away a leaflet containing present truth.”





More than eighteen centuries have passed since the apostles rested from their labors, but the history of their toils and sacrifices for Christ's sake is still among the most precious treasures of the church. 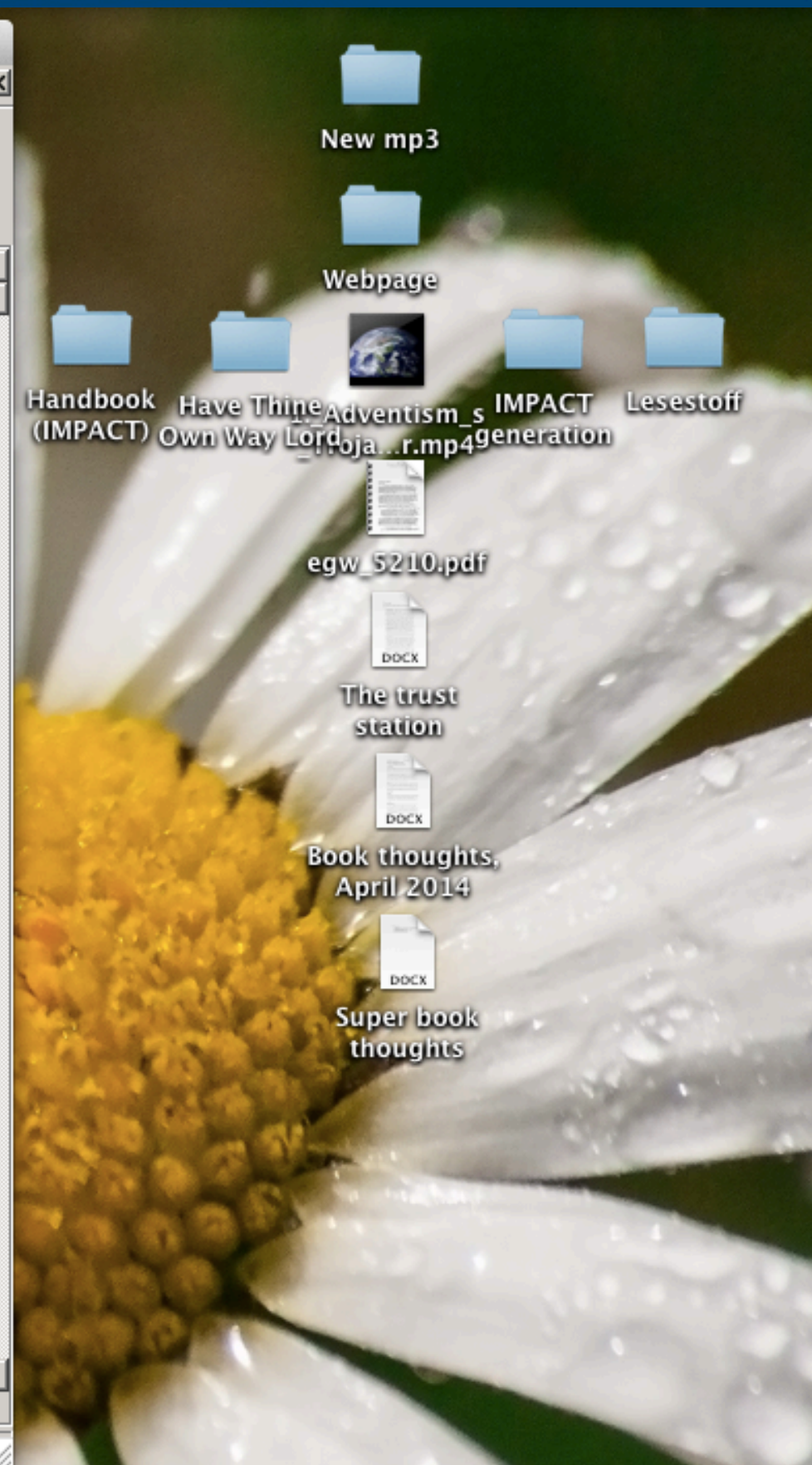
Glorious were the results that attended the ministry of the chosen apostles of Christ. At the beginning of their ministry some of them were unlearned men, but their

consecration to the cause of their Master was unreserved, and under His instruction they gained a preparation for the great work committed to them.
