





Supreme Court rules in favor of same-sex marriage nationwide

- Washington (CNN) (June 26, 2015)
- In a landmark opinion, a divided Supreme Court on Friday ruled that same-sex couples can marry nationwide, establishing a new civil right and handing gay rights advocates a historic victory. In the 5-4 ruling, Justice Anthony Kennedy wrote for the majority with the four liberal justices. Each of the four conservative justices wrote their own dissent.



Here are the key excerpts on religious liberty from the Supreme Court's decision on gay marriage: June 26, 2015 (Washington Post)

The case has raised questions over how legalizing gay marriage would affect religious institutions. During oral arguments in March, Justice Samuel Alito compared the case to that of Bob Jones University, a fundamentalist Christian university in South Carolina. The Supreme Court ruled in 1983 the school was not entitled to a tax-exempt status if it barred interracial marriage.



Solicitor General Donald B. Verrilli Jr., arguing for the same-sex couples on behalf of the Obama administration, said,"You know, I don't think I can answer that question without knowing more specifics, but it's certainly going to be an issue. I don't deny that. I don't deny that, Justice Alito. It is -it is going to be an issue."

 "Hard questions arise when people of faith exercise religion in ways that may be seen to conflict with the new right to same-sex marriage—when, for example, a religious college provides married student housing only to oppositesex married couples, or a religious adoption agency declines to place children with same-sex married couples. Indeed, the Solicitor General candidly acknowledged that the tax exemptions of some religious institutions would be in question if they opposed same-sex marriage. See Tr. of Oral Arg. on Question 1, at 36–38. There is little doubt that these and similar questions will soon be before this Court. Unfortunately, people of faith can take no comfort in the treatment they receive from the majority today." Chief Justice John Roberts.

Obama's LGBT Executive Order endangers religious liberty. July 21, 2014. FoxNews.com

- President Obama signed an executive order Monday barring federal contractors from discriminating on the basis of sexual orientation and gender identity – ignoring the pleas of Christian and other faith leaders to include an exemption for religious organizations.
- o The executive order would prevent Christian and other religious organizations with federal contracts from requiring workers to adhere to the tenets of their religious beliefs. Christianity Today reports the order could impact religious non-profits such as World Vision, World Relief and Catholic Charities.
- Last month, National Security Adviser Susan Rice told a gathering at the White House Forum on Global LGBT Human Rights that it was their responsibility to sway theological thinking on the LGBT issue. "For the faith community, how can we reinforce to religious groups that God loves all the children of his creation equally?" she asked the crowd. "Change will come," she went on to say. "It's already coming."

City of Houston demands pastors turn over sermons

"The city of Houston has issued subpoenas demanding a group of pastors turn over any sermons dealing with homosexuality, gender identity or Annise Parker, the city's first openly lesbian mayor. And those ministers who fail to comply could be held in contempt of court."



The New York based Catholic League for Religious and Civil Rights issued a statement Tuesday saying Pasadena Public Health Director Dr. Eric Walsh should not keep his post at the city. League President and CEO Bill Donohue said after learning of Walsh's sermons, many of which express discriminatory views toward homosexuals, Muslims, Catholics, popular culture icons, and others, he thinks Walsh is not qualified for the position in public health. He states, "Dr. Walsh is not fit to be the head of Pasadena's Public Health Department. It is not worth attempting to rebut the man's bigotry, so outlandish is it. Anyone whose judgment is that impaired has no legitimate role to play in public life." Pasadena Star News. May 6, 2014

- Oregon Labor Commissioner Brad Avakian on Thursday ordered the owners of a former Gresham bakery to pay \$135,000 in damages to a lesbian couple for refusing to make them a wedding cake.
- o Bakery owners Melissa and Aaron Klein cited their Christian beliefs against same-sex marriage in denying service. The case ignited a long-running skirmish in the nation's culture wars, pitting civil rights advocates against religious freedom proponents who argued business owners should have the right to refuse services for gay and lesbian weddings.

"This has been a terrible ordeal for our entire family. We never imagined finding ourselves caught up in a fight for social justice," they said. "We endured daily, hateful attacks on social media, received death threats and feared for our family's safety, yet our goal remained steadfast. We were determined to ensure that this kind of blatant discrimination never happened to another couple, another family, another Oregonian."



 The Sweet Cakes by Melissa car was vandalized and broken into twice. Photographers and florists severed ties with the company, eventually forcing Sweet Cakes to close the Gresham shop in September 2013. The business now operates out of the couple's home in Sandy.

Leaders from those groups pledged on Friday to seek legal means to shield their beliefs from state interference.

- One of the statement's signees, Russell Moore, president of the Southern Baptist Convention's Ethics & Religious Liberty Commission, called "religious liberty" the "next front in the skirmish in American life."
- The skirmish will likely endure for years, Moore said at a press conference on Friday, with casualties on both sides.
- "One of the most tragic results we could possibly see is an unrelenting cultural war from progressives toward those who dissent because of deeply held religious convictions."



- Many visitors to Germany can find themselves standing outside a closed department store, perplexed to find that they cannot do a bit of shopping during their weekend trip. This is a result of Germany's long-held resistance to Sunday shopping even in the face of growing consumerism.... The labor unions had joined the churches in their campaign to ring-fence Sunday as a day off for the nation. However, their focus was not on protecting the right to practise religion, but rather on protecting workers in the retail sector from having to work on Sundays, sometimes the only day they might get to spend with other members of their family. The services union Verdi greeted Tuesday's ruling with "relief and joy," saying this was a boon to shopworkers and their families.




