


NAHUM 1:9

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What do you conspire against the Lord? He will make an utter end of it. **Affliction will not rise up a second time**.



How can God allow us freedom of choice for all eternity, yet guarantee no one will ever choose to rebel again?



The answer to this critical question is found in a study of the Second Coming of Jesus and the events immediately preceding and following Christ's return.



2 Peter 3:3-7

... scoffers will come in the last days, walking according to their own lusts, and saying, "Where is the promise of His coming? For since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of creation."



2 Peter 3:9, 10

The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is **longsuffering toward us**, **not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance**. But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up.





If unfallen angels and the redeemed of humanity have finally rejected Satan, why give him any more time to live?






Satan's continued existence beyond the Second Coming only makes sense when we understand God's process for judging the world.

Fear God and keep His commandments, for this is man's all. For God will bring every work into judgment, including every secret thing, whether good or evil.




Daniel 7:9–14

Revelation 22:11, 12



In this pre-Advent judgment, the **VERDICT** of each case is rendered by Jesus Christ.






When Jesus returns, the righteous dead will be resurrected and join the righteous living in the air.



1 Thessalonians 4:16, 17

For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.





At the same time, the living wicked will die, thus gathering all the wicked together in the grave.



Revelation 20:4

And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.





Though Christ judged the world **BEFORE** His return, another work of judgment is entrusted to the redeemed **AFTER** His return.



1 Corinthians 4:5

Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and reveal the counsels of the hearts.


The Great Controveray, p. 661

At this time the righteous reign as kings and priests unto God. John in the Revelation says: "I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and judgment was given unto them." "They shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years." (Revelation 20:4, 6). It is at this time that, as foretold by Paul, "the saints shall judge the world." (1 Corinthians 6:2).




In union with Christ they judge the wicked, comparing their acts with the statute book, the Bible, and deciding every case according to the deeds done in the body. Then the portion which the wicked must suffer is meted out, according to their works; and it is recorded against their names in the book of death.





In this post-Advent judgment, the **SENTENCE** of each case is rendered by Jesus Christ in cooperation with the redeemed.





Removing all doubt as to His fairness and justice, Christ invites the redeemed—the only inhabitants of heaven who can fully sympathize with the wicked—into His deliberations about the destruction of the lost.

Isaiah 45:22-24

"Look to Me, and be saved, all you ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other. I have sworn by Myself; the word has gone out of My mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, that to Me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall take an oath. He shall say, 'Surely in the Lord I have righteousness and strength. To Him men shall come, and all shall be ashamed who are incensed against Him.



For thousands of years this chief of conspiracy has palmed off falsehood for truth. But the time has now come when the rebellion is to be finally defeated and the history and character of Satan disclosed. In his last great effort to dethrone Christ, destroy His people, and take possession of the City of God, the archdeceiver has been fully unmasked.

His accusations against the mercy and justice of God are now silenced. The reproach which he has endeavored to cast upon Jehovah rests wholly upon himself. And now Satan bows down and confesses the justice of his sentence.



Every question of truth and error in the long-standing controversy has now been made plain. The results of rebellion, the fruits of setting aside the divine statutes, have been laid open to the view of all created intelligences. The working out of Satan's rule in contrast with the government of God has been presented to the whole universe.








