# Book of Life

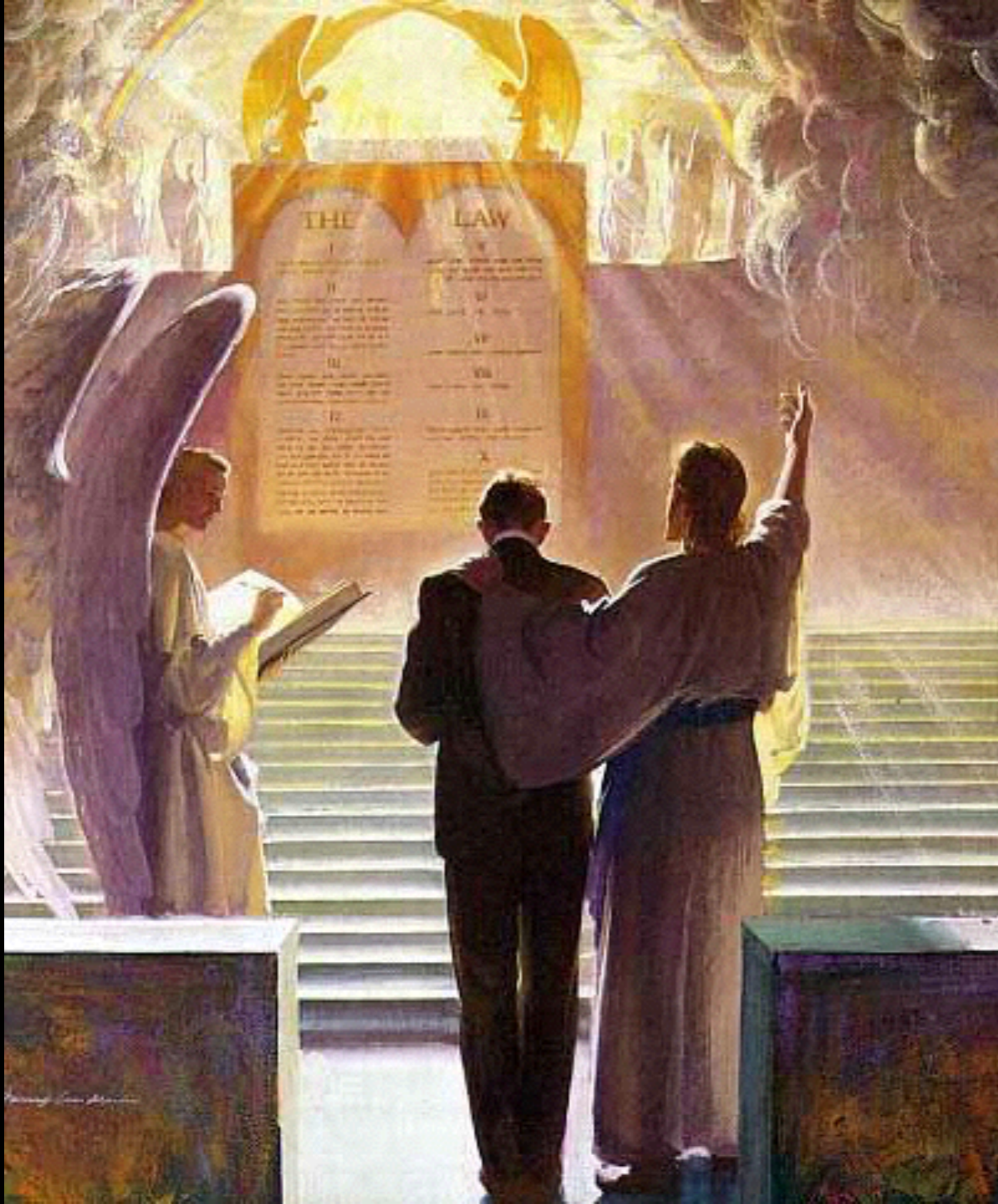
