Daniel 11:40

- And at the time of the end shall the king of the south push at him: and the king of the north shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, and with horsemen, and with many ships; and he shall enter into the countries, and shall overflow and pass over.



Who is the King of the South?

- King of the South is identified as Egypt (Daniel 11:8-9)
- Pharaoh does not acknowledge the true God (Exodus 5:2)
- Egypt is connected to Sodom (Revelation 11:8)
- Egypt represents the pleasures of sin for a season (Hebrews 11:24-25)
- The culture of Egypt and Sodom was sexual immorality (Leviticus 18, Jude 7).



Here are the key excerpts on religious liberty from the Supreme Court's decision on gay marriage: June 26, 2015 (*Washington Post*)

- “Indeed, the Solicitor General candidly acknowledged that the tax exemptions of some religious institutions would be in question if they opposed same-sex marriage. See Tr. of Oral Arg. on Question 1, at 36–38....
- “Unfortunately, people of faith can take no comfort in the treatment they receive from the majority today.” Chief Justice John Roberts.



King of the South Attack Against Religious Liberty:

- Mayor Annise Parker of Houston, Texas demanding pastors to turn in any sermon notes that speaks against homosexuality (10-14-2014)
- Dr. Eric Walsh fired as Pasadena Health Director because of Adventist sermons he preached (May 6, 2014)
- Oregon bakery fined \$135,000 for refusing to bake a cake for same-sexed couple because of their religious convictions. *The Oregonian*: July 2, 2015



King of the South Attack Against Religious Liberty:

- A lay minister who is suing the Georgia Department of Public Health for religious discrimination has been ordered by the state's attorney general to relinquish his sermons to the government, according to federal court documents. "Please produce a copy of your sermon notes and/or transcripts," Attorney General Samuel Olens wrote to attorneys representing Dr. Eric Walsh. Fox News: October 26, 2016



Daniel 11:40

Who is the King of the North?

- The King of the North is identified to exalt himself, magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against God of gods (Daniel 11:36-37)
- The Little Horn power speaks great words against God and change times and laws (Daniel 7:25)
- The Son of Perdition exalts himself above God and show himself as God (2 Thessalonians 2:3-4)
- The beast speaks great things and blasphemies against God and His tabernacle (Revelation 13:5-6)

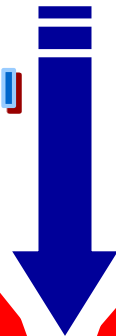

- A nation that is founded on Christian principles and the separation of church and state that will ultimately persecute Christians.



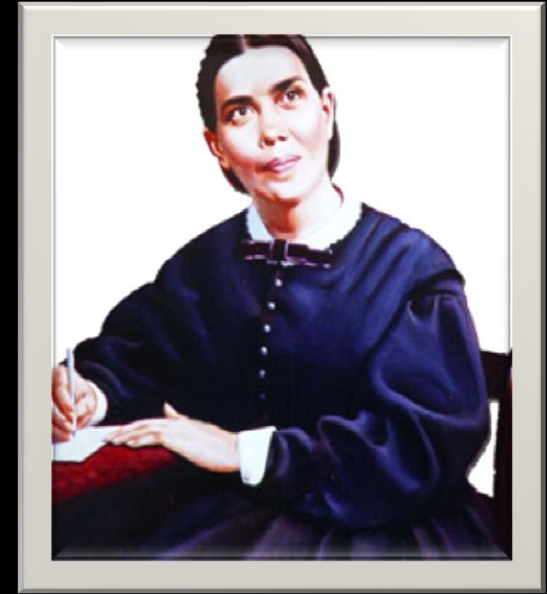
Time Magazine: August 15, 2016

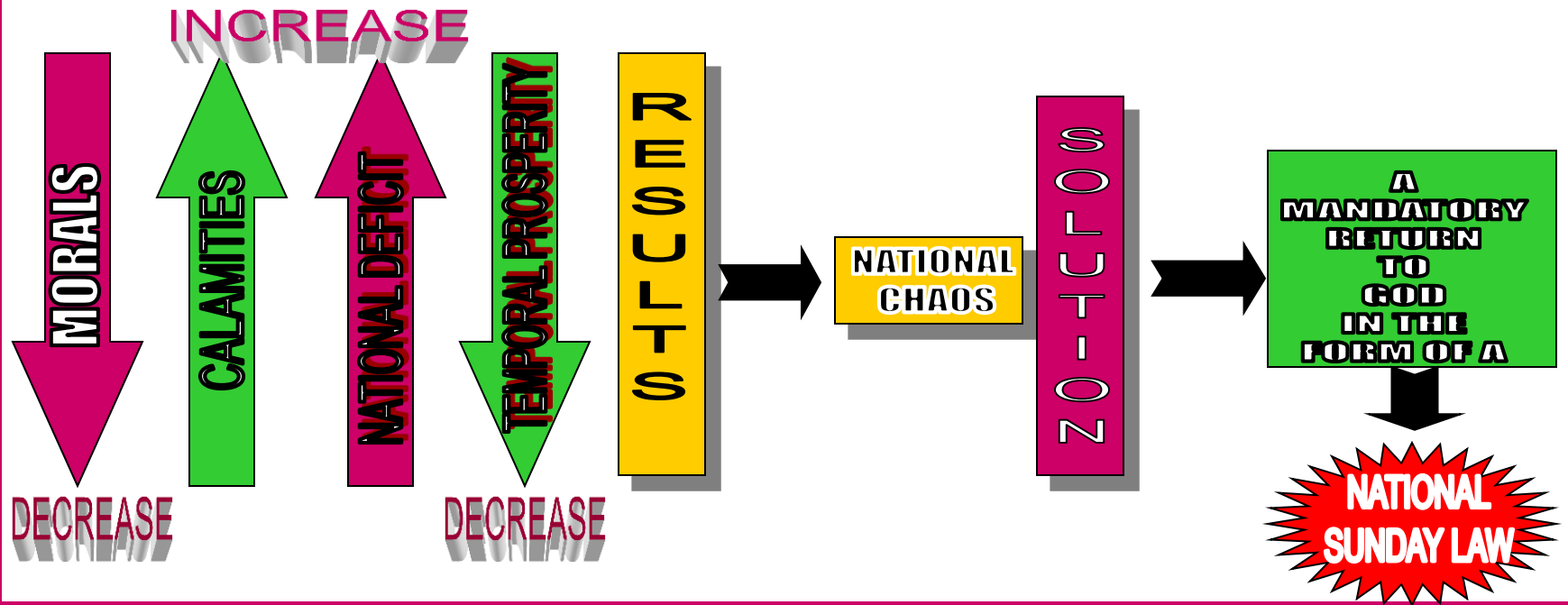

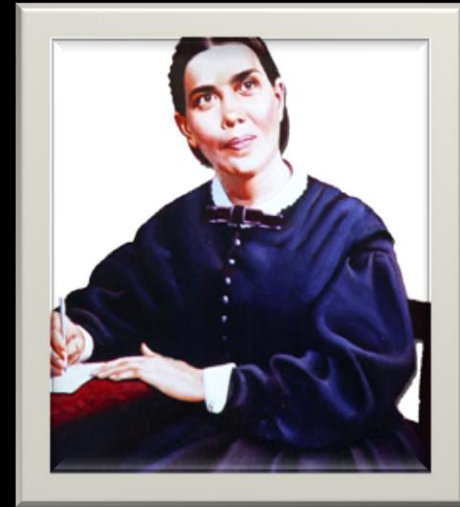

Fundamentals of Christian Education page 475

- “The Lord would have His people bury political questions. On these themes silence is eloquence. Christ calls upon His followers to come into unity on the pure gospel principles which are plainly revealed in the word of God. We cannot with safety vote for political parties; for we do not know whom we are voting for.... We cannot labor to please men who will use their influence to repress religious liberty, and to set in operation oppressive measures to lead or compel their fellow men to keep Sunday as the Sabbath. The people of God are not to vote to place such men in office; for when they do this, they are partakers with them of the sins which they commit while in office. ”

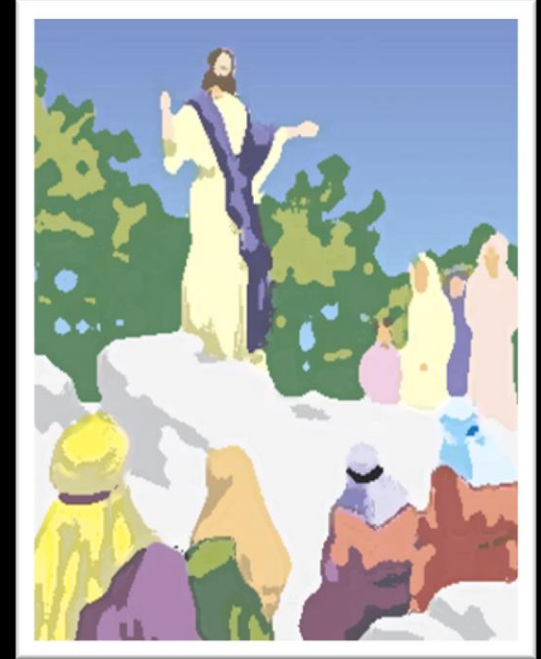

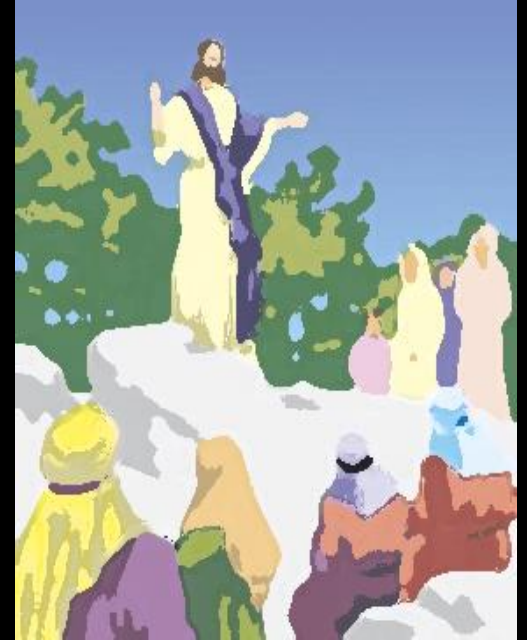

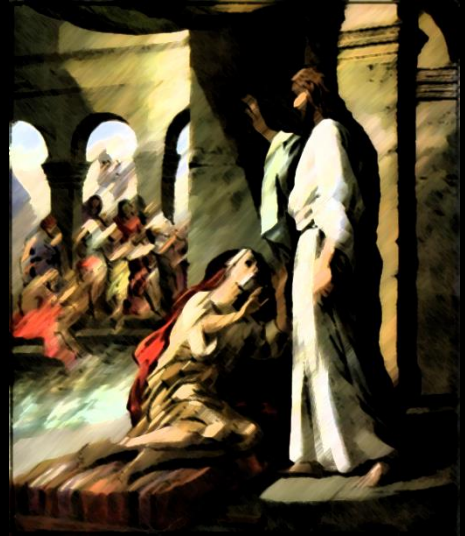
Matthew 4:17

- “And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.”



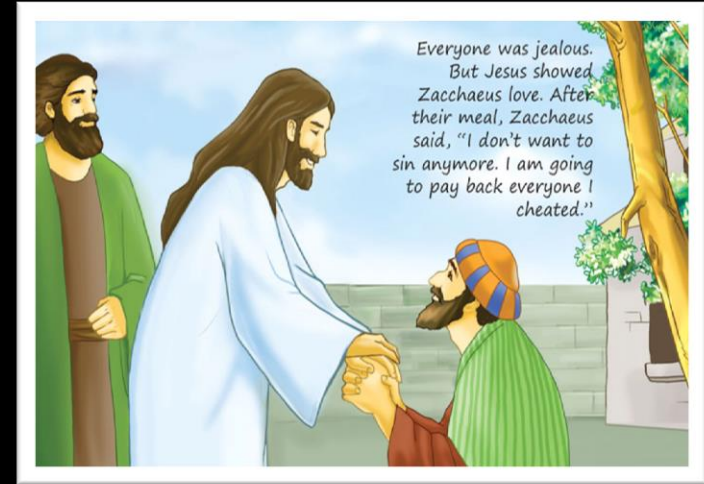
John 12:32

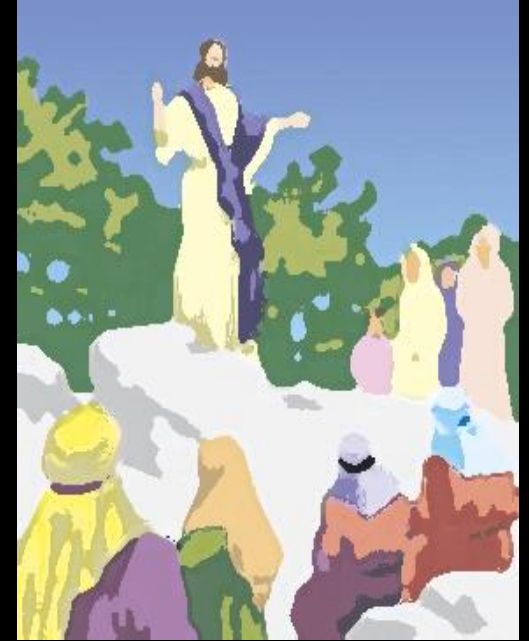
Matthew 22:20-21

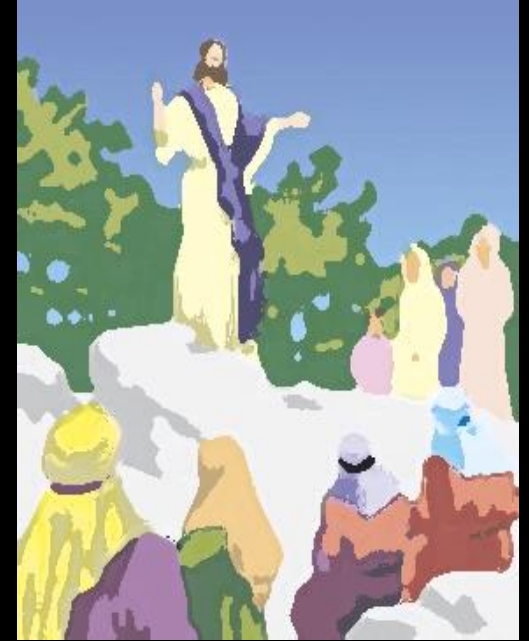
John 4:39-41

- Healed a Roman Centurion's servant (Matthew 8:5-10)



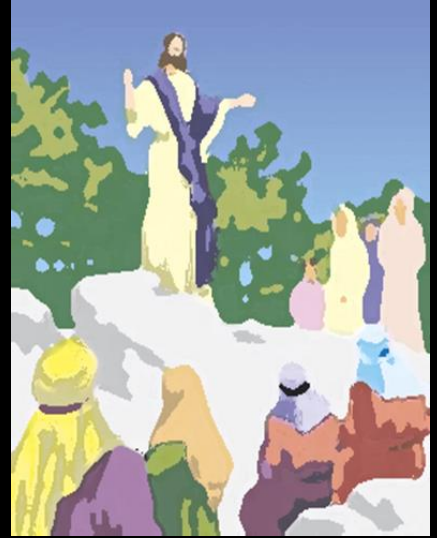
John 18:35-36

Three Angel Messages:
