1. Location:

"The Creator chose for our first parents the surroundings best adapted for their health and happiness." MH 261

"The home of our first parents was to be a pattern for other homes as their children should go forth to occupy the earth. That home, beautified by the hand of God Himself, was not a gorgeous palace. Men, in their pride, delight in magnificent and costly edifices and glory in the works of their own hands; but God placed Adam in a garden. This was his dwelling.... In the surroundings of the holy pair was a lesson for all time — that true happiness is found not in the indulgence of pride and luxury, but in communion with God through His created works." PP 49.

2. Occupation

The Creator of man knew that this workmanship of His hands could not be happy without employment. Paradise delighted their souls, but this was not enough; they must have labor to call into exercise the organs of the body." HR July 1, 1872.

"The Creator of man never designed that he should be idle It was the law of nature, therefore the law of God, that brain, nerve, and muscle, should be in active motion.... Exercise in useful labor will be carrying out the original plan of God, when He bade Adam and Eve to dress the garden." HR May 1, 1873

3. Family Life

"Without companionship the beautiful scenes and delightful employment of Eden would have failed to yield perfect happiness. Even communion with angels could not have satisfied his desire for sympathy and companionship.... Eve was created from a rib taken from the side of Adam, signifying that she was not to control him as the head, nor to be trampled under his feet as an inferior, but to stand by his side as an equal, to be loved and protected by him." PP 46

4. Education

"The system of education instituted at the beginning of the world was to be a model for man throughout all aftertime." Ed 20

"The book of nature, which spread its living lessons before them, afforded an exhaustless source of instruction and delight. On every leaf of the forest and stone of the mountains, in every shining star, in earth and sea and sky, God's name was written. 2. Occupation



"By the distribution of the land among the people, God provided for them, as for the dwellers in Eden, the occupation most favorable to development — the care of plants and animals." Ed 43


3. Family Life
