SOUTHBAY


- New church plant



- Hospital sponsorship
 - Finances

 - Population health nurses
- 2017 outcomes
 - SBP down 15mmHg, wt loss 2lbs







DWTD Transformed

- Started measuring Data (NAPV = 1462)
- Implemented small groups/discussion
- Intentional about invitations to subsequent events
- Intentional about spiritual references
- Future: move to church home

DARP

- Fall (currently in session)
- Growing
 - 2017 (15 attendees w/ 4 on waiting list)
 - 2018 (26 attendees)
 - Also run "inpt" program about 60mi away
- NAPV: 310
- Bible Studies

Five Day Plus Smoking Cessation Program

- Remake of the original 5day program
- Changes:
 - Interactive discussions
 - Utilizes short youtube videos on smoking plus 8 laws of health
 - Spiritual support including prayer and scripture promises
 - Ongoing spiritual and weekly support

Inspired Counsel

- "Medical missionary work and the gospel ministry are the channels through which God seeks to pour a constant supply of His goodness. They are to be as the river of live for the irrigation of His church." -- Bible Echo, Aug. 12, 1901.
- Conclusion: When medical missionary work is done utilizing this combined approach, there is little need for a "bridge" program to transition to Bible study because the Bible has been a part of the program from the beginning.
