- Interest rates to remain

- Why home prices may go down: Prices tend to go down in earnest if full-blown recession hits and people start losing their jobs.

- Why home prices may not go down: Under-supply of housing for some time and the supply chain disruptions have further reduced housing inventory. Low mortgage rates locked in.
- YMMV: Real estate prices vary dramatically between regions.
- **Save!** Best thing to do is save up as big of a down payment as humanly possible.
